## Addendum A

### Financial Terms of Participation – Solo Studios 2026

1. Participating Fee  
Participating in Solo Studios is free of charge i.e. no entrance fee.
2. Commission Structure
  - In principle, a commission of 20% is payable to Solo Studios on all art sales during the event or as a direct result thereof.
  - Where participants incur a significant cost of sales (for example a Gallery which acquires art works to on-sell), Solo Studios will consider commission proposals individually with those participants.
3. Advance Deposit

- An advance **deposit** of R10,000 is payable, per participant, by the due date as stipulated in the agreement.
  - The advance deposit paid is deducted from commissions due on your art sales, which will be reflected on the invoice upon completion of the event.
  - Where the deposit of R10,000 is refundable assumes that, per participant, there would be a minimum of R50,000 in sales (i.e. R50 000 sales x 20% comm=R10,000, where the commission is at 20%). Should sales fall short of this target, the balance remaining of the advance deposit post sales and commission due, will be WAIVED by the participant.
  - The advance deposit is non-refundable, both in the event where the participant has not reached the target in sales to justify the R10,000 deposit off-set in commissions, and if for any reason beyond the event organisers' control, the event has to be cancelled or postponed.
4. Exemptions
- Exemptions or waivers to the above deposit due terms may be considered at the sole discretion of the organizers, in the following instances. For example:
- Non-profit organizations, and/or community development initiatives.
  - Where an offering may be considered of exceptional interest and value to the event's experience. This activity which may not necessarily generate financial reward.
  - Where a participant has exceptional marketing value, which may draw additional interest in and attendance to, the event.
  - Where the organizers deem it of value to invite an artist, celebrity or social media influencer as a guest participant.
